# 紐約華裔小姐初選面試 三十三佳麗登場展風采



三十三位參選佳麗大合照

二〇〇五年度紐約華裔小姐競選於六月十二日進行最後一次面試。分有三個環節表演，三十三名參賽者首先有兩分鐘時間自我介紹，再穿著泳裝回答司儀提問，以及自選才藝表演。由於面試佳麗未正式進行受訓，不少參賽者在臺上表現有點緊張。參選者大部份是大學生或剛從大學畢業的專業人士，有的出生在美國，有的小時候隨家人移民到美國籍貫為廣州、香港、福州、上海、西安、大連、溫州、遼寧、天津、台灣。雖然在美國長大，許多佳麗能講流利粵語或普通話。

到來面試的佳麗大多由家長和朋友相伴下出席，並接受大會工作人員資格審核及與籌委會成員會面。其中不少佳麗上臺表演第一輪環節兩分鐘自我介紹時，大多表示希望參選來增加人生經驗和自信，加上家人朋友的鼓勵和支持，讓她們鼓起勇氣參加選美。其中一位報名參選佳麗陳珊，曾獲全美華埠小姐第一名，在臺上表現充滿自信。不少佳麗說參選的結果並不重要，只是享受參選的過程，能夠豐富人生經歷，有機會挑戰自我。布魯克大學一年級十九歲學生陳明貞說，參加選美可以挑戰自己，幫助自己成長。二十歲的美容師陳麗說，從選美可以學到很多東西，如化妝、儀態、提高個人素養。十九歲皇后學院學生王維，選美是對美的追求和美的享受，她希望通過選美發掘自己的潛能，豐富人生經驗，留下美好的回憶。廿一歲福建籍的黃麗琴說，她很羨慕氣質高雅的美女，

希望能象她們那樣展示自己的美，同時也借選美磨練意志，使自己更成熟，也學習面對失敗的勇氣。前來捧場的黃麗琴的媽媽說，女兒想當演員，做母親的希望她能夢想成真。而三十三名佳麗中，年齡最小的是來自紐約上州只有十七歲的零白莎。

紐約華裔小姐選美的董事主席葉彬介紹，此次華裔小姐選美比賽已經舉辦了四屆，但這次確是第一次將面試現場對外公開化，而且也是舉辦這個活動以來最大的一屆，目的是讓大家可以更多更好地參與進來，也可以讓這個活動得到更多人的瞭解與支援。這次比賽參賽選手數量、水平檔次是歷屆比賽所沒有的。在比賽選手中，大部份是第一次或第二次參加選美比賽，但大都表現的沈著冷靜，熱情大方。在自我介紹時，有引用親身經歷抒發感想者；有引吭高歌表達自己心情者；也有閱歷豐富才藝精湛者。在才藝表演時是八仙過海各顯神通，無論唱歌跳舞，大家都表演出了非常專業的藝術水準，得到了在場評委們的一致好評。參與評選的評委包括董事主席葉彬、總裁江漢輝、執行總裁阮健華、評審主席麥炯星會計師和美容顧問及髮型顧問等。由於紐約華裔小姐選美是與國際華裔小姐選美比賽相關，此次獲獎的冠軍不僅會得到一萬元的獎金，還會被推薦到香港參加國際華裔小姐競賽，所以整個競選的評判標準也非常嚴格。

## 【佳麗培訓紀事】

On June 15, 2005 was the first official training for the Miss NY Chinese Pageant 2005. The contestants had introduced themselves by stating their names and why they wanted to join the pageant. Some of the girls had felt pretty nervous when talking in front of a big group and hope that this pageant will help them improve their speech and self esteem. There were other contestants that



were not shy when talking in front of big groups. Contestant #11 Jenna Chen was one of the girls that were not nervous when talking in front of large groups and she had stated in her introduction that she likes to talk to people. Contestant #1 Shan Chen and contestant #12 Diana Ji were other contestants that was not nervous when talking in front of a large group because they had other pageant experience as well.



The image consultant Lucy Liang had went over the schedule of the pageant for the next couple of months.



The contestants will be wearing 3 outfits chosen by the organization and they will be wearing these outfits for press conference and events. All the outfits worn by the contestants during events and press conference will be sponsored by organizations. It is very important that every contestants show up for all the trainings and event scheduled by the Miss NY Chinese Pageant organization. When contestants don't show up for events and trainings it will damage their scores.

On June 16, 2005 was the second day of the training. Lucy Liang our image consultant for the Miss NY Chinese Pageant will be doing most of the pageant training and also following up on the contestants. In today's training



Lucy had showed the video of the interview at Golden Bridge Restaurant. She had talked about each contestant's interview. She had talked about what was good about

their interview and what they should be changed. She also had talked about how each girl should present themselves to make they look good. Contestants had discussed what should be improved on other contestants. Most contestants had shared thoughts with each other. Lucy had said that how you present yourself is really important because you always want people to have a good first impression of you. If you don't make a good impression to people the first time they see you it might affect you in the future. This training basically talked about how each person should package themselves to make a good impression to people.

On June 17, 2005 was the third training of the Miss NY Chinese Pageant. Today's training is about color analysis and Lucy had talked about the warm, cool and natural

color. She also talked about which color would match when it is put together. Contestant #3 Jessica Ping Ng had described what the warm and cool colors were. Contestant #11 Jenna Chen was the model to demonstrate



which color would match her skin tone. Lucy putted color clothes on Jenna to see if the color would match her and the other contestants pointed out which color matched Jenna.



Contestant #9 Nicole Weng was the next contestant to demonstrate which color matched her skin tone.

A few of the contestant like contestant #6 Cindy Lau, contestant #8 Yuna Yang, and contestant #13 Xixi Ye had gave their point of view on the type of color that would go together. Today's training basically talked about colors and how to put color together to sharpen your own personal image. When you wear your clothes and the colors do not match it can ruin the style.



On June 18, 2005 was our fourth training for Miss New York Chinese Pageant. Today the contestant had 4 1/2 hours of intense catwalk training. The training was taught by a professional catwalk instructor Cam Santanna.

During the training the instructor wanted to see what



experience the contestants have in catwalk. Some of the contestants had no experience in cat walking and the contestants that have had training in cat walking

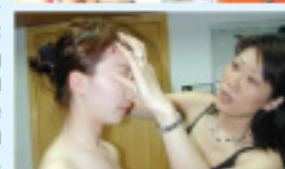

Katy tried different slimming products on contestant #3 Jessica. Katy explained how the product would make your body look more better. The third part of the training was taught by Katy and this part was about learning how to apply make-up. The



model of this part of the training is contestant #4 Cerilyn Huang. Katy showed the contestants the different way of applying make-

# 古西部戰場再現

時空回到1800年的美國西部，頭戴斗笠，四名來自中國的蒙面保鏢，護送一隻神秘的皮箱前往未知的目的地。途經一處荒僻的村落，卻引來當地牛仔的覬覦，惡鬥一觸即發。不料，另一股邪惡的勢力正悄悄滲入，目標也是這只皮箱...



以上是「美人奪寶記」(The good, the bad and the beautiful, 暫譯)，2005年紐約華裔小姐選美主題短片的劇情概述。為了完美演出這部4分鐘的短片，13位決賽入圍佳麗展開為期近2週的排練。其中最為人所矚目的，是緊張的武打場面，以及逼真的槍戰特效。

本片導演及編劇，Digital Art Video負責人 King Wang對多維記者說明他的構想：不同於過去的選美MTV，女孩只需要穿得漂漂亮亮，在風景宜人的公園走來走去，假裝自己在唱歌。今年我們想要有所突破，所以選擇難度更高的劇情短片形式。

剛開始構想時，原本想拍西部片。但因為主角都是中國女孩，所以嘗試將兩者融合。激烈的打鬥場面將是本片的重心，我們想呈現中國武術與西方槍戰對決的場景，具有強烈的視覺效果。

由於有劇情，所以入圍佳麗必須配合角色，做出不同造型。而她們所扮演的角色，也不再是人人愛愛的公主，而是有神秘的



武林高手，及粗獷的西部牛仔。打鬥場面是本劇的第一項挑戰。因為女孩沒有功夫底子，所以必須請武術指導個別訓練。

由於事件發生在古代西部，為求逼真，原本打算到亞利桑納州外景，但因時間預算的限制，選擇長島觀光小鎮Old Beth Page。那裡是一處古蹟，風景及建築幾可亂真。

也因為當地是古蹟，不能破壞，所有爆破及槍戰場面必須以電腦特效處理。在色彩上，為了表現時空感，將以昏黃為基調，模仿30、40年代的老片。而鏡頭語言將帶有史

蒂芬·史匹柏及吳宇森的風格，比如鏡頭跟隨著子彈前進，或是側身飛出射擊等。

另外一項挑戰，道具。劇務人員四處走訪跳蚤市場，上eBay網站，尋找可用的服裝及道具。如古董槍、牛仔裝、披風甚至古董馬鞍等，目的是為了逼真。

本片將於8月20日在決賽地點國際豪華大賭場巨星劇場播放，將於決賽當日現場播放，請讀者拭目以待。究竟神秘皮箱內所裝何物？誰最後得到了這件寶物？當晚也將同時揭曉。

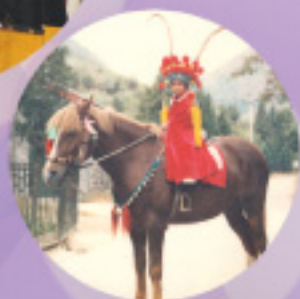
